

Call for applications

Maupertuis research prize from the Schweizerische Hirnliga (Swiss Brain League)

In 2024, the Schweizerische Hirnliga will be awarding **a prize in the amount of CHF 100,000** to a Swiss research group for outstanding scientific work in the field of brain research. The prize is given for the scientific achievement of a work group as a whole.

The prerequisite is that the research has been published <u>as a single publication</u> in the two years prior to the call for applications or has been accepted for <u>publication</u> by an internationally recognized journal. The research must also have been conducted primarily at Swiss clinics and/or institutions.

Applications are to be submitted electronically (Word or PDF format) along with the scientific publication and declaration of intent explaining how the prize money will be used, a brief CV with a list of publications for each researcher, and an informed consent declaration signed by the authors. Applications must be **submitted via email** (info@hirnliga.ch) **by September 30, 2023.**
